


Q1. What do you think are the major challenges older tongzhi (or LGBTQ) are facing in Hong Kong? (Can choose more than one option)









5. Are there any other comments, questions, or suggestions?

- Additionally, you need to seriously think about how to balance the visibility of the
 organization. If the organization becomes more well-known and its name reflects its
 target audience, it may discourage some closeted older tongzhi who need support.
 However, if the organization remains less known, it is harder to reach those in need or
 secure funding.
- Among older tongzhi we've interacted with, many don't know Grey and Pride exists, so you should strengthen your outreach and promotion efforts.
- Currently, the organization should not focus only on older adults (60+); the target should start from middle age. In society, there have already been many elderly-focused services. Grey and Pride should aim to establish a local visible network of older tongzhi, fostering mutual support among service recipients in the community.
- I am already 88 years old. I think you should try applying for more grants so that Grey and Pride can have a physical location—a home base for both you and the people you serve. Through these grants, you could also hire staff to better meet the needs of older tongzhi, providing appropriate care for their various requirements.
- I am an elderly home operator and would love to share resources and services that may benefit the Grey and Pride community.
- I am not very familiar with your organization yet.
- I don't understand the difference between the needs of older tongzhi and other older people. I don't think society addresses the sexual needs of heterosexual seniors. If that's correct, then society has no obligation to address the sexual needs of aging tongzhi. Or have I overlooked something? If not, older tongzhi should be treated the same as other older adults and seek the same assistance.
- I hope you can do more community education at different schools. Thank you!
- I'd like to meet more older tongzhi.
- Is the organization specifically for the gay community? Are there any volunteer opportunities where we can help both the lesbian and gay communities?
- Now that you're a registered NGO, you can apply for various grants to run activities, such as addressing current mental health issues among older people.
- Please continue to care for older tongzhi who live alone. They are almost invisible in society, yet when they were younger, they worked and paid taxes. Society shouldn't abandon them in their old age.
- Recruit more older tongzhi to join and adopt a strengths-based approach to empower members. This can include organizing self-help groups that not only provide emotional support but also introduce more professional knowledge.
